## 2020 Competition Procedures/Local Rules

### **Tee Booking**

Tee times should be booked as normal in BRS for up to 4 players, with names of all players to be entered into the system. Competition entry will be between the hours of 7.30am and 6.00pm.

**PLEASE DO NOT ARRIVE AT THE CLUB MORE THAN 15 MINUTES BEFORE YOUR TEE TIME.**

### **On Arrival**

One member of your playing group only, should report to the Professionals Shop to confirm the names of those entering the Competition and to collect a scorecard and brown envelope.

Entry to the shop will be strictly one in, one out in order to maintain social distancing.

### **Competition Play**

Regardless of the type of competition, all players names and Handicaps should be clearly entered onto one card, which should then be marked by the player in your group with the lowest handicap. Scores should be clarified verbally and the card should then be signed by the marker only and not passed amongst players.

**PLEASE REMEMBER TO REMAIN 2M APART DURING YOUR ROUND, DO NOT TOUCH ANY EQUIPMENT THAT DOESN'T BELONG TO YOU AND REMEMBER NOT TO TOUCH THE FLAGSTICKS.**

### **After your round**

All completed cards should be posted through the letter box on the main door of the Clubhouse together with the appropriate entry fee in a clearly named, brown envelope. These will be collected by the Handicaps Committee the following day in order for scores to be entered and results processed.

Whilst we will process the results as quickly as possible, safety is our priority so please bear with us as results will not be available as quickly as normal.

**PLEASE REMEMBER NOT TO GATHER AROUND THE CLUBHOUSE OR IN THE CAR PARK AFTER YOUR ROUND AS WE MUST ENSURE THAT SOCIAL DISTANCING IS MAINTAINED.**

### **LOCAL RULES**

#### **Flagsticks/Holes**

Ball lifters have been fitted to allow players to remove the ball from the hole without touching the flagstick. The flagstick should remain in the hole at all times and scores will be acceptable for either competition or supplementary score purposes. The ball is considered holed if any part of the ball is below the surface of the putting green, even if not lodged against the flagstick.

#### **Bunkers**

All bunkers will remain in play with players restoring the sand with a club or their foot.

A modified version of Rules of Golf MLR E-3 is to be used and reads:

When a player's ball lies in any bunker, the player may take free relief once by placing the original ball or another ball in and playing it from this relief area:

Reference point: spot of the original ball

Size of relief area measured from the reference point: 6 inches from the reference point but within these limits;

Limits on location of relief area: must not be nearer the hole than the reference point and must be in the bunker; the bunker must not be smoothed before placing.
